Topics will include:

- Workflow of microplastics characterization, from sample preparation to data analysis, using Raman spectroscopy
- Analysis of morphology and chemical ID of microplastics using Particle Correlated Raman Spectroscopy (PCRS)
- Review of new functionalities for automated and batch analysis

Training certificates will be given to every attendee upon completion of the training.
